SET-Plan Conference is tackling the climate challenge with new technologies

Finland's Presidency of the Council of the European Union will organise the annual SET-Plan conference (European Strategic Energy and Technology Plan) on 14–15 November 2019 in Helsinki. This event will focus on energy research and innovation as a driver for the competitiveness of European industry on the road to a climate-neutral society.

How do technologies and R&I respond to the climate challenge - where are we going?

The topics of the various sessions will include industrial carbon dioxide emissions, coupling between energy sectors and developments in renewable energy. The conference will also address low-carbon technologies, innovations in nuclear energy, and the role of women in the energy sector and in promoting clean energy.

The conference will be opened by **Antti Rinne**, Prime Minister of Finland. Other speakers will include **Jean-Eric Paquet**, Director-General of DG Research and Innovation of the European Commission, **Martin Pei**, Executive Vice President and Chief Technology Officer of SSAB and **Petteri Taalas**, Secretary-General of the World Meteorological Organisation. The two-day meeting will feature over 50 presentations and debates in 11 sessions. Approximately 400 policymakers, researchers, entrepreneurs and stakeholders from across Europe are expected to attend.
